

His Excellency, Governor Biodun Oyebanji of Ekiti State is the first alumnus of Ekiti State University to serve as Governor of the state. A graduate of Political Science in 1989, he returned to his alma mater in 1993 to lecture in the Department of Political Science until 1997. Governor Oyebanji played a pivotal role in the creation of Ekiti State in 1996, serving as the Secretary of the Committee for the state's creation. His career spans the public and private sectors, including key roles as Special Assistant, Special Adviser, Commissioner, Chief of Staff to various Ekiti State Governors, and Manager of Treasury and Financial Services at the defunct Omega Bank (now Heritage Bank).

Governor Oyebanji's distinguished public service record includes chairing the Governing Board of the Citizenship and Leadership Training Centre at the Federal Ministry of Youth and Sports Development (2009-2010),

heading the Office of Transformation Strategy and Delivery (2011–2013), and serving as Secretary to the Ekiti State Government from 2018 until his election as Governor in October 2022. Outside politics, he is actively involved in agribusiness as Chairman of Con Dois Farms Ltd. His outstanding leadership has earned him multiple accolades, including the Silverbird TV, Vanguard, and Energy Times Governor of the Year awards.



Senator Opeyemi Bamidele, CON, is a successful Lawyer and Politician, the current Majority Leader of the 10th Nigerian Senate since July 4, 2023. Born on July 29, 1963, in lyin Ekiti, Ekiti State, Bamidele spent his early life in Lagos State, where he attended Baptist Academy secondary school. He holds multiple academic credentials, including a bachelor's degree in religious studies from Obafemi Awolowo University, a bachelor's degree in law from the University of Benin, and a master's degree in law from Franklin Pierce University. He was called to the Nigerian Bar in 1992 and the New York Barin 1999.

Bamidele has had a storied career in law and politics. He served as a defense counsel for Moshood Abiola during his treason trial and worked closely with the current Nigerian President, Asiwaju Bola Ahmed Tinubu (when he was the Governor of Lagos State between 1999 and 2007) in various capacities, including as Special Assistant on legal matters and Commissioner for Lagos State Ministry of Youth, Sports and Social Development. He was elected as a House of Representatives' member of the 7th National Assembly in 2011 and has been representing Ekiti Central Senatorial District in the Nigerian Senate since 2019. Bamidele has received several honors, including the Commander of the Order of the Niger (CON) award in 2022. He is a Honourary Life Member and Patron of EKSU Alumni Association. Some of his contributions to the University include the donation of Medical Students' Hostel (Phase I and Phase 2). Also, Radio Station and Mini Stadium which are under construction.




Dr. Olufuyi has participated in significant geological study teams and

Dr. Alle furthered his education with a master's degree in Global Affairs &


